It provides a summary of the basic requirements and other pertinent information about the election process. Specific requirements may be found in the Edgewater Home Rule Charter, the Edgewater Municipal Code, Colorado Revised Statutes and the Colorado Fair Campaign Practices Act.

Each candidate should pay particular attention to the **Fair Campaign Practices Act**, which is provided in the packet. **YOU are responsible** for the filing of the appropriate documents in a timely manner. Please note that, within ten days after you become a candidate, the "Candidate Affidavit" form must be filed with the Edgewater City Clerk.

The City of Edgewater will participate with Jefferson County in a 2025 Coordinated Election. A complete list of the vote centers are available on the Jefferson County's website at [www.jeffco.us/elections/](http://www.jeffco.us/elections/). Early voting at designated locations will be mailed to those electors with an active request, not sooner than 15 days before an election and no later than 22 days before an election.
