2026 HEALTHY TREE CANOPY PROGRAM

Request a visit from the City Arborist to inspect your trees. Let Edgewater assist you in maintaining a healthy urban forest! Rebates are available for qualifying properties.





**STEP 1:
SCHEDULE YOUR
SITE VISIT ON
ASKEDGEWATER**

**YOUR AskEdgewater REQUEST

- The number of affected trees.
- Any details that you can provide about specific concerns or conditions.
- Note you'd like an inspection from the City Arborist.



**STEP 2:
CITY ARBORIST
WILL PERFORM
SITE VISIT**

The City Arborist will visit your property within 10 business days and confirm eligibility for the Healthy Tree Canopy Program. If your property is eligible, you will receive a quote within 7-10 business days from the City's contractor with pricing for needed tree services.



**STEP 3:
REDEEM YOUR
COUPON!**

2026 COUPONS 25-75% off, up to \$500 (max) per resident.

If eligible, the City will provide the resident with a rebate of 25-75% off, up to \$500. The removal or treatment must be provided by the City's licensed tree contractor. Rebate amounts will be determined using 2026 HUD income limits. Properties not eligible for a rebate are still eligible for services using the City's contractor.

To receive the rebate, residents must provide annual household income to confirm eligibility. The owner must also agree to use the City's licensed tree contractor.

Once an owner accepts the quote from the City's tree contractor, their rebate will be deducted from the final bill. The property owner will be responsible for the remaining invoice cost.

The City's licensed tree contractor will submit an invoice to the City of Edgewater to collect the balance from the rebate.

WHAT IS ELIGIBLE?

Emerald Ash Borer Treatment

The Emerald Ash Borer is not in Edgewater, but has been found in Lakewood. An Ash Tree must be in good condition, and be deemed suitable for treatment by the City Arborist.

Infested Tree Removal

Trees that have an untreatable insect or disease with no hope of recovery may be eligible for removal. Examples are Mountain Pine Beetle and Tussock Moth.

Preventative Tree Removal

Dead or dying trees can be dangerous!

Once a tree is at least 50% percent dead, the tree will never recover and should be removed. Large limbs (greater than six inches) that are dead and creating a hazard to surrounding areas may also be eligible for the program.

Planting

Residents can plant a tree themselves, or have one planted by the City's contractor.

The planting location must be pre-approved by the City Arborist and the tree is required to be on the Front Range Tree Recommendation list:

*For trees planted by a resident, the City Arborist will confirm the planting and the resident must provide receipt of purchase to the City to be eligible for a rebate.
